Counselling Services

What is counselling?

Counselling is a therapy based service for individuals, couples and families that provides an opportunity to share and discuss personal concerns, challenges or goals with a professionally trained counsellor in a private and safe environment.

Counselling can assist with:

- Clarifying concerns
- Gaining understanding
- Considering alternatives
- Setting goals
- Implementing strategies

Lutheran Care Counselling

Lutheran Care offers counselling services for individuals, couples and families who may be experiencing challenges or difficulties. Our key priority is to listen and work with you to strengthen personal wellbeing, family relationships and ensure the safety and wellbeing of children.

All Lutheran Care counselling sessions are delivered in a safe, confidential and supportive environment where personal thoughts, feelings and concerns can be openly shared and considered.

Our professionally trained counsellors respect the importance of each person’s lived experiences, spirituality and emotional wellbeing and the influence this has on their relationships. We listen to your concerns and work with you to develop strategies and skills to achieve positive outcomes that are valuable to you.

Our Services

Lutheran Care’s counselling services offer professional support to people of all ages, backgrounds and cultures with our trained and experienced counsellors.

We offer a range of different types of counselling providing the flexibility for people to choose the service that best suits their current needs.

We offer:

- Family and Relationship Services (FaRS)
- Specialised Family Violence Services (SFVS)
- Education and Training (school outreach, parenting classes)
- Programs for CALD Communities

Counselling services can be delivered in individual, couple or group based settings. Sessions are 60 minutes in length.

Referrals

If your individual support requirements fall outside of our scope of practice, you may be referred to another agency or practice. This is simply to ensure that you receive the most appropriate support to meet your goals and needs.



Confidentiality

Lutheran Care counselling services maintains confidentiality except where a mandatory reportable offence (e.g. child abuse) has been disclosed or where there is a risk of harm to yourself or another person.

Counsellors receive professional supervision to ensure high standards of service are maintained. The supervisor is strictly bound to maintain confidentiality. All identifying information is removed in supervisor and counsellor discussions.

Lutheran Care participates in Government Information Sharing Guidelines for the benefit of the people it serves, for the safety of those who are vulnerable and to avoid duplication of information. Except where legal requirements determine otherwise, participants in our service would provide consent before any information is shared.

You may access your records on request.

Payment information

Fees are assessed according to household income, listed below.
